POSITION SUMMARY

The DSP Overnight Medication Trained level performs a variety and varied level of support to individuals served. This position has the responsibility of the administration of medication.

Minimum Qualifications:

Education	High School Diploma or Equivalent.
Experience	Served six months in a Direct Support Professional role and successfully completed Medication Administration Training.

Certifications	<p>Children's Program: Current in MANDT, CPR, First Aid certification, and Medication Administration Certification. LMC Drivers License as applicable to the position.</p> <p>Adult Program: Current in MANDT, CPR, First Aid certification, Medication Administration certification, and LMC Driver's License. If not current, must obtain within 30-day of employment.</p>
Special Considerations	<p>Special considerations include age requirements to meet state agency regulations and/or to meet insurance carrier requirements (i.e. KDOT, KDHE).</p> <p>Driving positions must maintain a good driving record</p> <p>Some environments/shifts prefer same sex staff.</p>

Function	Frequency
Walking and Standing	Up to 70%
Sitting	Less than 40%
Bending / Squatting / Reaching	Less than 30%
Visual and Auditory Acuity	100%
Moving/Lifting – 50 lbs.	More than 20%
Manual Dexterity	More than 590%
