

## Children's Treatment Program – Residential – Psychologist

### POSITION SUMMARY

This position will work with children with developmental disabilities and co-occurring psychiatric diagnosis, in a residential environment, providing behavioral consultation, composing positive behavioral support plans, providing technical assistance, and staff development.

### Minimum Qualifications:

Education	Master Level Psychologist.
Experience	Experience working with individuals with mental retardation is preferred.
Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ability to communicate with persons evidencing a wide range of types of disabilities.</li> <li>• Ability to maintain satisfactory attendance.</li> <li>• Ability to be flexible and work in a variety of classrooms and community settings.</li> <li>• Ability to assist students in self care, feeding, and toileting.</li> <li>• Establish and maintain effective working relationships.</li> <li>• Excellent communication skills (i.e. written, etc.).</li> </ul>
Certifications	<p>Current State of Kansas Psychologist license.</p> <p>Obtain during the first 30-days of employment: Safe Crisis Management, CPR, and First Aid. Certifications must be maintained on an ongoing basis.</p>
Special Considerations	<p>Special considerations include age requirements to meet state agency regulations and/or to meet insurance carrier requirements (i.e. KDOT, KDHE, Kansas CMS [PRTF]).</p> <p>Driving positions must maintain a good driving record.</p>

### Frequency Factor of Physical Demands:

Function	Frequency
Walking and Standing	Up to 100%
Sitting	Less than 10%
Bending / Squatting / Reaching	More than 70%
Visual and Auditory Acuity	More than 90%
Moving/Lifting – 50 lbs.	More than 20%
Manual Dexterity	90%

### Working Conditions:

- Exposure to animals.
- Fast paced environment with interruptions, distractions, and deadlines.
- Flexibility to changing support needs of individuals served.
- Physical requirements include utilizing Mandt, First Aid, CPR, transferring/supporting, etc.
- Driving/transporting persons served on an as needed basis.
